Before You Leave Home

Please print out and complete the parking pass before you leave home. As you are approaching campus, place the parking pass on your dash.

Move-in Procedure

- **Step 1** Place your parking pass on your dash as you arrive on campus. Then, locate your residence hall's unloading zone (additional directions are available on our website).
- **Step 2-** You and your helpers will report to your residence hall cart station where you will fill out a cart slip, receive a wheeled cart, and helpers will receive wristbands.
- Step 3- Unload your vehicle.
- **Step 4** Move your vehicle to long-term parking. **You will receive free parking on the day of your arrival with this parking pass.** Please keep it on your dash where it is visible.

Long-Term Parking - After You Unload Your Vehicle at Arrival

Lower Campus:

Soldiers and Sailors (4101 Fifth Ave)

(Clearance Height: 6'4")

From Forbes, take a left onto Bellefield Ave, then take a left onto Fifth Ave. Take a right onto Bigelow Blvd and the Soldiers and Sailors Garage will be on your left.

Posvar (122 Roberto Clemente Dr)

(Clearance Height: 6'4")

From Forbes, take a right onto South Bouquet St. Then, take a left onto Roberto Clemente Dr. The garage will be on your left.

Upper Campus:

OC Lot (3505 Aliquippa St)

(Clearance Height: 7'0")

From Fifth, take a right onto Darragh St. At the top of the hill, take another right onto Aliquippa St. Follow the signs, the lot will be to the left.
